The information inscribed herein was collected by Muungano wa Wanavijiji youth from Mukuru, Mathare, Huruma, Kiambiu, and Kisumu. We are aiming to collect information and report on it every day throughout the election period.

The information presented here captures the current situation and presents the picture of the current realities within the aforementioned settlements.



HURUMA

- Businesses are yet to resume normal operations.
- Shops are operational but not adequately stocked. Some commodities are unavailable.
- A normally busy street within the settlement stands deserted at 7:30pm with fewer socio-economic activities ongoing.
- Communities are awaiting the presidential results. A lot of uncertainty exists over the election outcomes



MUKURU PIPELINE.

- No significant changes have taken effect since 9th August. Most shops remain closed, and in the few shops that are open, traders have taken advantage of the current election period to arbitrarily hike commodity prices.
- There are few residents on the streets



MUKURU VIWANDANI

- Situation is calm in Viwandani
- Residents have resumed work, although, fewer residents are out on the streets.
- Residents are upholding peace although tensions remains high as they await the presidential results.



MUKURU KWA NJENGA

- No significant changes have taken effect since 9th August.
- Kwa Njenga, Member of County Assembly (M.C.A) elections will be repeated on 23/08/2022 as earlier announced by the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC).
- Young people are dependent on handouts. Few youths demanded money and gifts from the Member of Parliament (MP) elect. Disputes ensued after although the police contained the situation.
- Police in the area are maintaining order, no cases of police brutality have emerged.

MATHARE

- This morning there were allegations of voter bribery. This was reported by more than one agent from one particular polling station.



KIAMBIU, KOSOVO

- The area was identified as a hotspot during last year's elections although, in this current election, no tensions have emerged.

- The situation is calm. Normalcy has resumed.
- Youths are in a celebratory mood as they await the presidential results



KOSOVO, MATHARE

- Businesses are resuming normal operations.
- There is no tension. Emerging reports reveal, that gangs in the area are planning to take advantage of the presidential announcements to cause chaos.
